CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Conference is the fourth in a series, and follows the very successful Underground Singapore 2001, 2003 and 2005 Conferences. The purpose of the Conference is to provide a forum for the discussion of issues relevant to the design and construction of underground works in Singapore. The aim is for contractors, engineers, owners and researchers to share and discuss their experience. Papers on underground construction in Singapore are particularly encouraged, but papers on relevant work outside Singapore would also be welcome.

Papers on case studies of underground construction in Singapore are particularly welcome. Case studies should include a summary of the subsurface conditions, details of the project, including construction methods and sequence, and monitoring results. Interesting observations and construction difficulties encountered can be included where appropriate. Back-analysis of the results, where carried out, is welcome, but is not mandatory.

Abstract format:

Abstracts should be prepared as a MS Word text file and consist of:

- Paper title
- Authors names and affiliations
- A brief summary of the proposed paper, no more than 400 words
- Contact details (address, telephone, fax, email) of one of the contact person
